All teams are contingent on the amount of interest, coaches, and facilities.	

Team Expectations:

- All team members will need to have a completed medical clearance by a physician. This
 form will only need to be completed once a school year. For example, if your child has
 participated in Cross Country during the same school year, they will not need to complete
 another form. A copy of the form can be found here: Medical Evaluation Form. This form is
 due by August 1st to Coach Goodwin or Mollie Shepherd.
- 2. Parents and/or guardians are responsible for providing transportation to and from practices and game locations.
- 3. All interested players should be ready to learn and have an interest in playing volleyball with their classmates.
- 4. All skill levels are welcome. If we have too many players for the number of teams/coaches, there will be an evaluation process.

Registration:

Registration opens May 15th, 2025

Registration closes August 1st, 2025

Team Fees:

The fees will include: practice t-shirt, uniform rental, coaching, facilities, league fees, and end-of-the-season banquet. We will collect uniforms at the end of the season.

Team Practices/Games:

The team will practice twice a week at Rio. The game schedule will be determined by the MAAC. Once we receive this information, we will communicate with parents immediately.



Attendance Expectations:

Players are expected to attend all practices unless sick or injured. Players and or parents must communicate with the head coach for excused absence. If any practices are canceled, the head coach will communicate through Gamechanger. If a player is missing practice, this may affect playing time.

Transportation:

Parents are responsible for picking up and dropping off their athletes at the designated game and practice locations. For games, we will communicate via weekly email for any early dismissal times needed for athletes to get to their games on time. Please abide by school policies for picking up any siblings early for athletics.

Clothing & Equipment:

Players will be responsible for wearing the appropriate clothing and gear to each practice and game. This includes tennis shoes, athletic clothing, knee pads, and a water bottle.

Academic and Behavior Expectations:

Student-athletes competing on the St. Benedict's volleyball team are students first and then athletes. Academics remain the utmost priority; should grades become an issue, a meeting will be held between coaches, teachers, administrators, and student-athletes to decide on appropriate actions.

Students are always representing St. Benedict's Episcopal School in training and games. Behavior during games and practices should be the same as when in school. We ask that athletes respect themselves and others, remain focused, always do their best, and follow the rules we establish as a team.

Safety during our team training must always be the top priority. Student-athletes must remain focused and safety-conscious. If behavior becomes an issue, dismissal from the team may be the final consequence of inappropriate behavior. Remember, students represent themselves and our school on and off the field and should be honorable and kind to others!

Team Communication:

Our primary form of communication will be through the Gamechanger App. You can expect any schedule changes or practice updates through here. Once we have the official roster, you will be added to the team to receive notifications. Please make sure to download this app. In addition to Gamechanger, we will send a weekly email out to all parents for the week's schedule and longer updates.
