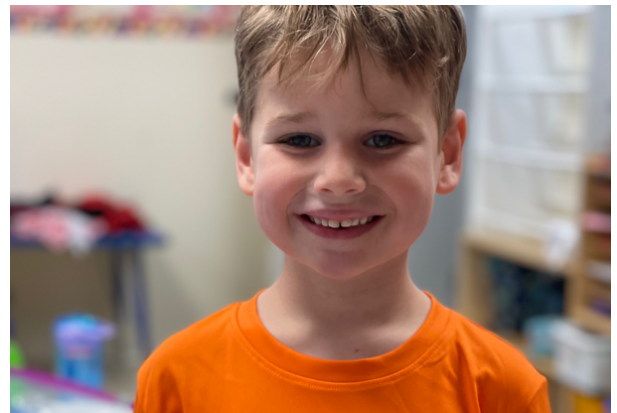

Registration

Parents (and/or guardians) must complete camp registration online through CampBrain. Registration for June clubs will close on May 21, 2023. Registration for July clubs will close on June 25, 2023. To receive Early Bird pricing and to avoid a \$50 late registration fee, please register before the camp closing date. See below for further information regarding changes, cancellations, and refunds. Registration is first come, first served. Parents must complete registration forms for each camper.

Qualifications for Preschool 1s Program

Children enrolling in camp must be at least 1 years old by September 1, 2023. We are not able to take students younger than this age requirement. **Camps are open to currently enrolled St. Benedict's families.**

Qualifications for Preschool 2s Program

Children enrolling in camp must be at least 2 years old by September 1, 2023. We are not able to take students younger than this age requirement. Camps are open to currently enrolled St. Benedict's families.

Qualifications for Preschool 3s Program

Children enrolling in camp must be at least 3 years old by September 1, 2022 and Potty Trained. If your child has not reached this qualification, they may sign up for the 2 year old camp (this option is only available to currently enrolled St. Benedict's families).

Changes

Changes in camp enrollment will be permitted up to 10 days prior to camp start with a \$50 change fee. If the cost of the new program is higher than the original, the difference will be charged to your account. If the cost of the new program is lower than the original, the difference will be credited to your account.

Cancellations and Refunds

All cancellations will be refunded as specified below. A \$50 change fee will be applied to each cancellation request.

- All Camps: 100% refund until April 30, 2023.
- June Camps: 50% refund until May 21, 2023, after which no refunds will be given.
- July Camps: 50% refund until June 25, 2023, after which, no refunds will be given.

St. Benedicts Cancellations

St. Benedict's will review all camp enrollment two weeks prior to the start of the camp. Any camp that has not met the minimum number required will be canceled and registered campers will be notified to select a new camp. If you are unable to make a new selection, a refund will be issued. St. Benedict's reserves the right to cancel any portion of a camp due to any unforeseen circumstances. In the event of a camp's cancellation, refunds will be issued.

Sunscreen | Insect Repellant

Parents must administer sunscreen and insect repellant prior to the start of the camp day.

Medication

Lunch*

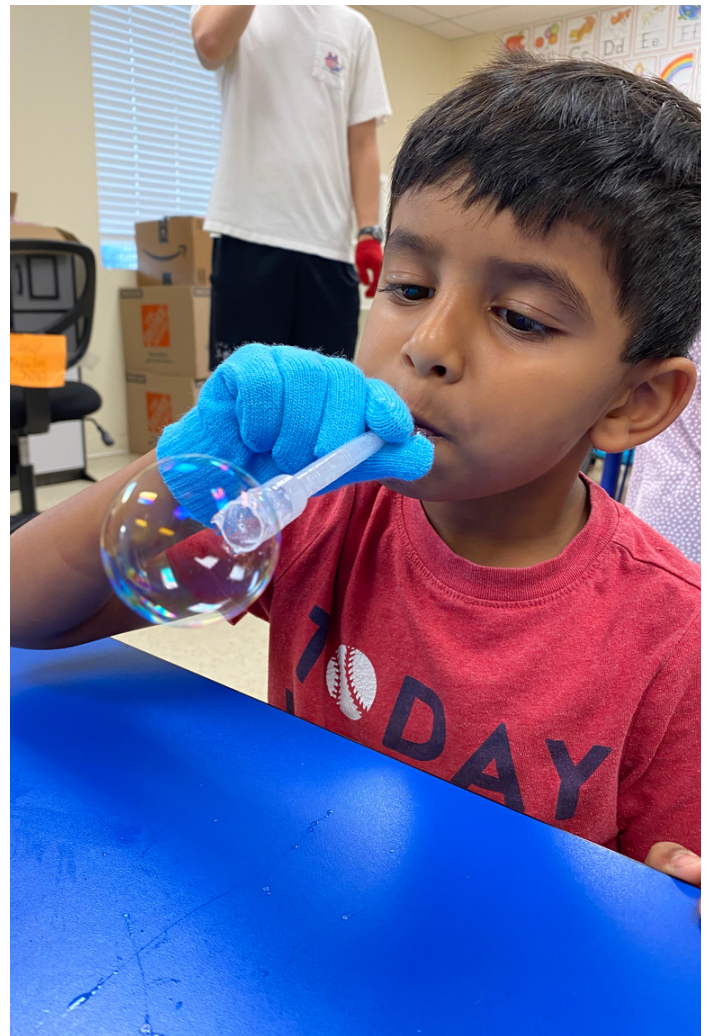

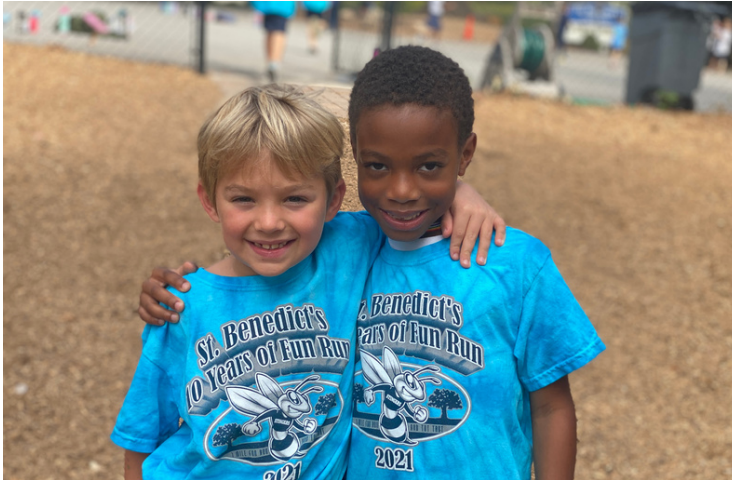

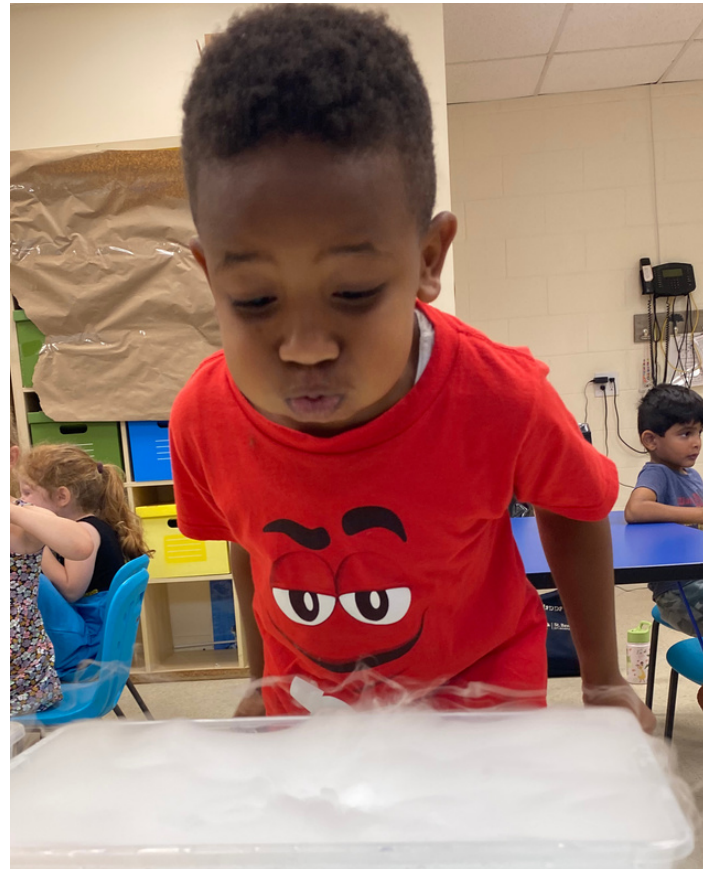
