- Christmas is celebrated in many countries around the world. In France, Christmas is called Noel. This stems from an ancient tradition in which farmers would use part of the log to ensure good luck for the next year's harvest. A long time ago, part of the log was used to make the wedge for the plough as good luck for the coming harvest.
